Per the Colorado Code of Regulations  
(8 CCR 1203-18)  
**Quarantine on the importation of Prunus Species into the San Luis Valley**  
We are unable to ship Native Plum or Manchurian Apricot to customers in the San Luis Valley (Alamosa, Conejos, Costilla, Rio Grande and Saguache counties) Sand cherry, Nanking cherry and Chokecherry however, are allowed.

If you do not live in the Fort Collins area, but are interested in obtaining any of the seedlings we produce, we encourage you to contact a cooperating agency near you. These cooperating agencies, which are comprised of Colorado State Forest Service District Offices, University Extension offices, and Natural Resource Conservation District offices, accept tree orders, and receive deliveries from the nursery each spring.

In addition to providing a more local point for customers to pick up seedlings, these agencies can offer insight into which plant species will work well in the area they serve.
